THE WINE

The Rued vineyard and the unique clone created from it, exude Chardonnay flavors that are always exotic and perfumed. This 'Musque' clone changes fruit tones from regular lemon to Meyer lemon, green apple to honeycrisp and nectarine to apricot. Added notes of beeswax and Jasmine flowers. Creamy lees in the barrel add to the textural depth of fruit on the palate. The bright citrus tones create a savory and crisp finish that would be a great pairing with your favorite seafood.

THE VINEYARD

Developed by the Rued family in 1969, the Purrington Rued vineyard is nestled on a southwest-facing hillside of Sonoma's Green Valley where it receives a cooling maritime influence from the Pacific. The sedimentary gravel and marine deposit laden soil bring out the best in its unique 'Musque'-type clone Chardonnay.
